

Early Childhood & Elementary Uniforms and Personal Appearance

ALL STUDENTS

- 1. All uniform items must be purchased from Ivy School Uniforms (with the exception of socks, shoes, and accessories).
- 2. Students are required to dress according to one's biological sex.
- 3. Only uniform sweaters, official embroidered CCA non-hooded sweatshirts or fleece CCA jackets may be worn over uniform shirts and blouses. Sweatshirts may not be worn on chapel days. Sweatshirts with hoods may not be worn with school uniform.
- 4. Only plain, solid white, short sleeved undershirts may be worn under oxford shirts. White, gray, or navy short sleeve undershirts may be worn under polo shirts. Long sleeve undershirts may not be worn under short sleeve uniform shirts or blouses.
- 5. Hats may not be worn inside buildings (unless part of an approved special dress-up day).
- 6. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.

GIRLS

In addition to the required and optional uniform items that are purchased from Ivy School Uniforms, girls will wear the following:

- Any solid white, solid black, or solid navy athletic shoe (required for PE days) or flat dress shoe (optional on non-PE days) with non-marking soles. No colored logos, colored laces, lights or other embellishments. No open toes or open heels. Saddle oxford shoes are also permitted.
- White or navy footed tights, knee socks, or fold-down bobby socks; White knee highs/bobby socks are required on chapel days. No patterned tights allowed; solid navy/white footed tights only. Low athletic socks or no-show socks are not allowed.
- Royal blue field trip polo shirt should be worn with khaki shorts, pants, or skorts for field trips.
- The uniform blouse (short or long-sleeved) must be worn with chapel jumper (PK 2nd grade) or chapel skirt (3rd 4th) on chapel days.
- Polo shirts may be worn with chapel jumper/skirt on non-chapel days.
- Girls may wear one pair of ear studs, one necklace, one ring, one watch and one bracelet (including rubber type). Hoops or dangling earrings are not permitted.
- Hemlines for skirts should be consistently maintained no more than 4" above the floor (when kneeling).
- Navy or black modesty shorts must be worn under chapel jumpers/skirts/dresses (not longer than the skirt or jumper).
- Hair should be kept neat, clean, and out of the face. Hair may not be streaked, dyed, or added to with
 any unnatural colors. A hairstyle should be in keeping with one's gender and should not distract other
 students or place undue attention on any one student, as determined by school administration.
 Headbands with animal ears or attachments/decorations other than a bow are not permitted.
- Nails must be short and neatly trimmed. Fake nails must be short and shaped/filed without points.
- Make-up or body glitter is not permitted.
- Hair accessories (headbands, bows) must be consistent with school/uniform colors.

BOYS

In addition to the required and optional uniform items that are purchased from Ivy School Uniforms, boys will wear the following:

- Any solid black athletic shoes with non-marking soles. No colored logos, colored laces, lights or other embellishments.
- Black, or navy crew socks are required all days. Low athletic socks or no-show socks are not allowed (socks must cover the ankle bone).
- Royal blue field trip polo shirt should be worn with khaki shorts or pants for field trips.
- Hair should be kept neat, clean, and out of the face. Hair may not be streaked, dyed, or added to with any unnatural colors. A hairstyle should not distract other students or place undue attention on any one student, as determined by school administration.
- Boys may wear one simple necklace, one ring, one watch and one bracelet (including rubber-type).

COLD WEATHER UNIFORM

Permitted

- o Long sleeved uniform shirts (available from Ivy School Uniforms).
- Solid navy or white long sleeve turtlenecks may be worn only under an official CCA sweatshirt or chapel jumper (on non-chapel days).
- Official CCA white/navy/gray/royal blue embroidered sweatshirts, gray/navy/royal blue fleece jackets, sweatshirts, and school sweaters may be worn over uniform shirts and blouses.
- o Non-CCA coats/jackets are permitted for outside play activities.

Not permitted

- Sweatshirts with hoods
- o On Chapel Days, sweatshirts are not permitted.
- Turtlenecks worn alone or under short sleeve shirts.
- o Long johns, leggings, warm-ups/sweatpants, yoga pants, pajama bottoms.

SPIRIT WEAR

- Top: Authorized CCA spirit shirts or sweatshirts with or without hoods are the only items allowed.
 Please do not wear plaid shirts, college sweatshirts, or any other name-brand outerwear over your spirit wear.
- **Bottom**: Solid colored (denim, black, navy, royal blue, orange, white, gray, or khaki only) shorts, skirts, or pants (including joggers) may be worn. Shorts and skirts must be standard uniform length.
- **Shoes**: Athletic shoes or other approved footwear (cowboy boots, *Sperry's*, *Tom's*, *or Ugg's* with socks are allowed) **Note:** If your child has PE on a Spirit Wear Day, shoes worn must be appropriate for play in the gym.
- Cheerleader uniforms <u>are</u> permitted. (skirt length no shorter than 4" above the knee)
- The following are not permitted:
 - Leggings
 - Distressed or ripped jeans
 - Sandals/open-toed shoes, flip flops, house slippers or Croc's
 - Exposed midriffs
 - Tutus or other costume-like clothing
- Students not complying with these directives will be sent to the office and required to call home. They
 will lose the privilege of wearing spirit clothing and will need a regular uniform brought to them before
 they will be allowed in class.
- Students not wishing to participate or ineligible* to participate must wear a regular uniform option.

FREE DRESS DAYS/SPECIAL DRESS

Occasionally students have the opportunity to dress up for special events such as Reformation Day, Western Day, and Children's Book Character Day. Dress should be modest. In addition to the requirements for Spirit Wear, the following are not permitted: spaghetti straps; halters; tank top; strapless tops or dresses; inappropriate writing or images on clothing. Leggings or yoga pants are ONLY permitted with a dress of acceptable length (4" above the floor when kneeling) worn over the leggings.

*Students who receive 3 Uniform "Oops! Notes" within a quarter will not be eligible to participate in Spirit Wear Days.
